### Best Bulletin Contest Rules

(This is a District-Oriented Award)

1. Contest Period: The Best Bulletin Contest covers the period of August 1 through April 2.
2. Entry: All club bulletins qualify (Lions, Lioness and LEOs). Each issue must be submitted to the DG, VDG and Contest Chair.
3. Awards: Awards will be presented at the District Convention. There will be awards for the top three (3) Lions Bulletins. There will be one award for Best Lioness Bulletin. There will be one award for the Best LEO Club Bulletin.  
Additionally, there may be one for the most improved. There also may be one for the Best Emailed Bulletin.
4. System of judging: Judging will be based on the 1,000 point system listed below. In case of a tie, decision from DG & Bulletin Chair will break the tie by a collective decision.
