District 4-L2 Lions and their loved ones a great Thanksgiving and Christmas. Continue to spread the Lions spirit throughout the holidays.

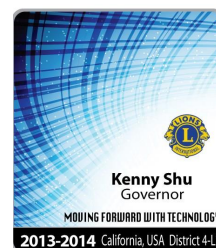

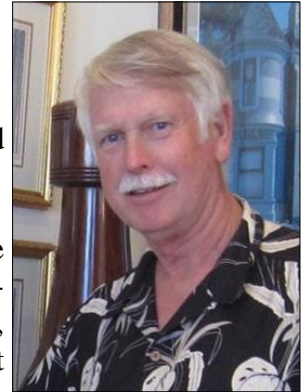
