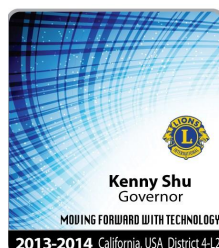
In my enthusiasm to hit the ground running for the upcoming year, I called a cabinet officers meeting on the very day of being elected! We Serve!
