Members are the foundation of our organization. As such, my goal is to complete all 49 club visitations by November. At the time of this writing, I have already visited six clubs.

International President Barry Palmer’s theme is *Follow Your Dreams*. Everyone has a dream. If you do not follow your dream, then it remains just a dream. But if you act, that dream may become reality.

When I visit clubs, I always ask club members, “Do you have a dream?” My dream is to grow our district’s membership by 10%. If we can all grow by **10-10-10**, (10% Club, 10% Zone and 10% Region,) then we will achieve our goal of 10% growth. These gains will put District 4-L2 number ONE of 15 in California instead of 3rd.

As of August 18, the clubs that have achieved 10% are the new Los Angeles Overseas Lions Club with 39 new members

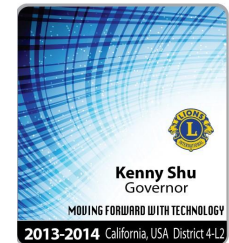
and West Covina Diamond Lions Club with 39%. Following closely is the West Covina Filipino Club with 9%. Where is *your* club on the progress chart?

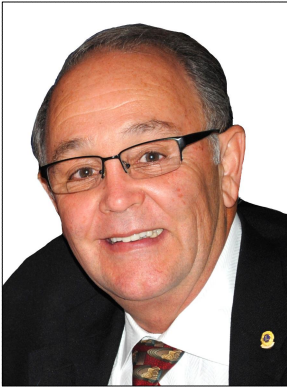

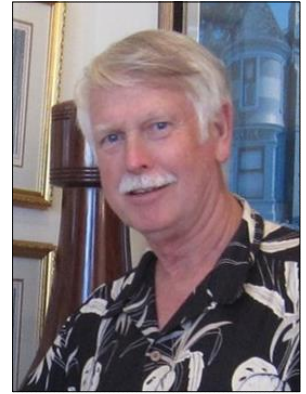

Words from 2nd Vice District Governor

Your district leadership has been busy with club visitations which began in early August and will be continuing for months. I see these meetings as a great opportunity to meet dedicated Lions in this great district and I have learned much from visiting each club.

Membership continues to be an area of concern for MD-4. At least, it became a big issue at the Council of Governors (COG) meeting in Walnut Creek. I have mentioned to some of you that I have been considering new ideas. When I put my thinking cap on I figured that since we tend to be visual learners, it would be helpful to have a regional map indicating our club locations.

After spending a few minutes on the internet, I ordered a Thomas Brothers L.A. Regional Map which I expect to arrive in time for our first district cabinet meeting. What I anticipate is that we will find cities within our district that do not have a Lions Club. With a community assessment, a meeting with the local Chambers of Commerce and possibly a visit to some city council sessions, I am betting that new clubs will form from this effort. Don't doubt me on this issue.

I have been assigned the district service project by DG Kenny Shu. My observation has been that we need additional vision screening services for young students. Spot Vision Screeners by Pedia Vision could be the answer. These cameras can accurately detect six areas of concern: farsightedness, near-sightedness, astigmatism, unequal refractive power, eye alignment measurement and unequal pupil size. Interestingly enough, the time it takes to screen a student is mere seconds. An entire class can be screened in less than 30 minutes. The information is then given to the school nurse or administrator via a flash drive. My plan is to write an LCIF grant for eight cameras, two for each region. This will truly be a district-wide service project. It is my goal to have the International President visit a school using a screener during his visit in December.

Since the cost of a unit is \$7,015, I am encouraging district-wide support to achieve this objective. Together we can affect the well-being of many of our youth.

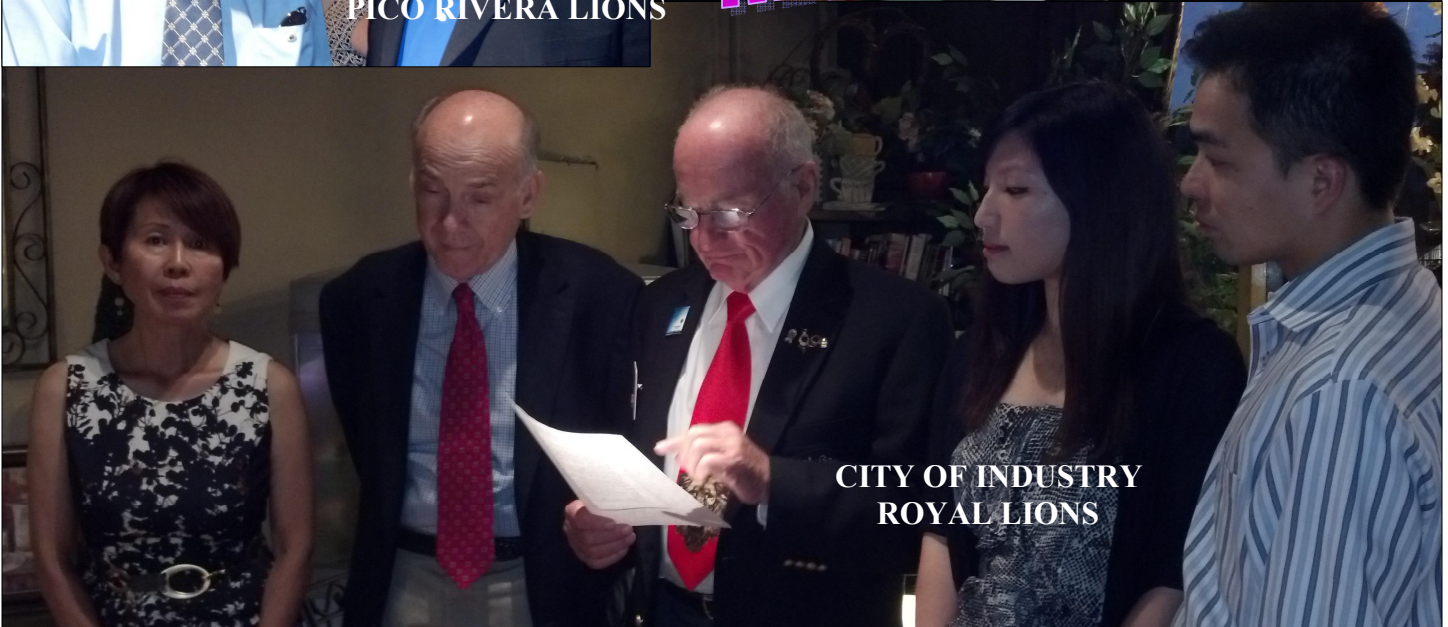
