Arne Ogaard of the Irwindale Lions Club is back! He will be riding 75 miles (120 km) on Route 66 – for the 2nd time



Arne will be riding 75 miles along Route 66 to help kids across the valley through a variety of programs. The proceeds from Arne's bike ride will benefit three organizations that focus on enriching the lives of children. With your help, the Irwindale Lions Club will continue to fund the **City of Hope, Joseph "Pepe" Miranda Sports Scholarships and Grants**, and the **Lions Camps at Tersita Pines for Disabled Youth**.

Anyone wanting to ride along with Arne is welcome. It would be fun to get a group of people together to ride this famous route. Just donate \$25, let us know you're coming, and show up at the start line! The route will begin at Irwindale City Hall at 7:00 a.m., go through 12 cities and two counties, and then finish back at City Hall. We estimate the ride will take approximately 8 hours, and won't break speed records, but be fun.

This ride is also quite special for Arne because when he and his family migrated from Norway to the United States in 1954, they traveled by car from Chicago to Los Angeles on the original Route 66.
