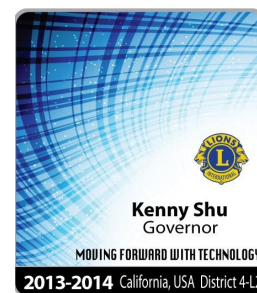
Our 3rd District Meeting is coming up on Saturday, January 25. I have invited Lion

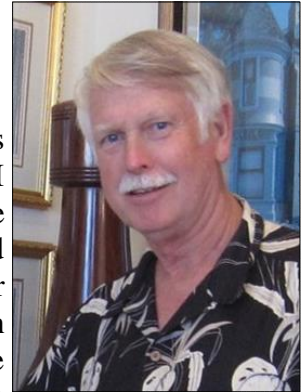
