

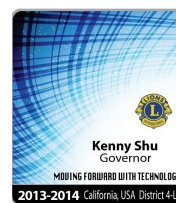

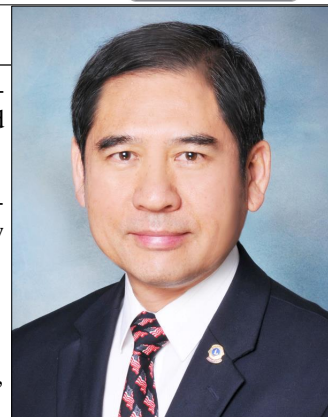
District Theme: “Moving Forward with Technology”

Words from 2nd Vice District Governor

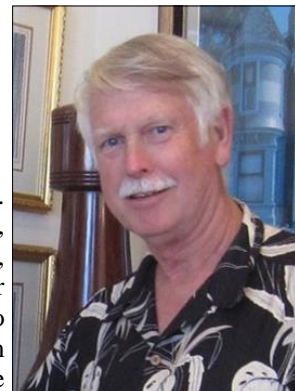
Lions of 4-L2,
