

Let me first thank you for your wonderful efforts last year when we raised \$1,029,626 in donations, the second year in a row you raised over \$1,000,000. Thank you for your support of MLERF, the only statewide project of the Lions of Massachusetts. We had nearly 100% support from our Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs.

Our goals this year are to again reach the \$1,000,000 mark and with 100% participation.

As Lions we have answered many challenges. In 1925 we accepted Helen Keller's challenge to be **Knights Of The Blind** and make it our mission to "eradicate preventable blindness". In1952 the Lions of Mass. responded to another challenge and formed MLERF. The Lions of Mass. first effort was historic. The first \$5000 Grant made to Harvard Medical School was instrumental in ending the scourge of Retinopathy of Prematurity or **Baby Blindness**. In the ensuing years over 150,000 babies sight was saved by the Lions of Massachusetts.



A farewell thanks to the Governors and the Board of Directors of The Mass Lions Eye Research Fund, Inc It's hard to single out any one person in particular because it was team work that enabled us to break all records this year. Also thanks to the Lions Clubs, Lioness Clubs and Leo Clubs who helped put us over the top. Since my July 12th letter many changes have taken place. District N came through with 100% participation and brought in a record total of \$73,670.84. District K increased their donation from last year by \$6447.42 and Y was a close second with \$6441.80.

THE LIONESS – "WE SERVE TOO" -- Total donations from the Lioness of Mass \$12094.23 - is also a record from the Lioness Clubs.

DISTRICTS-33Y: \$1751.73 33A:\$1187.50 33N \$0 33K: \$300 and 22S: \$8855 Total \$12094.23. The Fail River Evening Lioness won the plaque for the largest donation from a Lioness Club \$3000. The West Bridgewater Lioness won the plaque for the largest donation from a Lioness Club Per Capita at \$70.58. The Agawam Lions Club won the plaque for the largest donation from a Lione Club with \$7000.

The Acton and the Clinton Lions clubs were tied for largest donation per capita at \$96.77.

SOMETHING YOU MIGHT WANT TO KNOW - In addition to the grants of \$265,000 for Eye Research the Board of Directors voted \$2500 to Boston College for a Laser dual control instructional Laser Cane. This will be used by the college to train instructors that will be able to test Blind people to see if they can be adapted to the cane and also to train the ones that qualify to use the cane. In many cases this White Cane will be used instead of a seeing eye dog.
























At Children's Hospital Lions and Guests were able to move through 6 different presentations. Each one a research project funded with MLERF Grants including a Presidential Grant.

They provide a wonderful way to honor a fellow Lion or loved one and the donations are added to total MLERF donations.

BANK CHALLENGE

We think it is pretty safe to say that all of our clubs have a partner that handles our funds – your **BANK!** Many of our banking partners are supportive of our local fundraising efforts. However, if you have not asked your local bank for a donation for other events or projects we encourage every club to ask for a donation to **MLERF.**



Many of our clubs have members who are bank employees or officers and should be able and willing to help with an appeal for funds. Generally it is not a good idea to seek funds from a bank's "foundation" because they target specific community causes. Foundations generally do not give to other foundations or funds.

If you believe it is appropriate **PLEASE** ask your local bank for a donation to **MLERF.** Talk to the branch manager or the person with whom you may already have had contact. If you need a sample letter of introduction we can provide that. In fact a copy was included in your directory package. If you need our help – please ask. If you need numbers for their tax filings we can provide those because MLERF is a 501 (C) 3 and the bank can also benefit from their donation to MLERF.


