We think it is pretty safe to say that all of our clubs have a partner that handles our funds – your **BANK!** Many of our banking partners are supportive of our local fundraising efforts. However, if you have not asked your local bank for a donation for other events or projects we encourage every club to ask for a donation to **MLERF.**

Many of our clubs have members who are bank employees or officers and

willing to help with an appeal for funds. Generally it is not a good idea to seek funds from a bank's "foundation" because they target specific community causes. Foundations generally do not give to other foundations or funds.

If you believe it is appropriate **PLEASE** ask your local bank for a donation to **MLERF.** Talk to the branch manager or the person with whom you may already have had contact. If you need a sample letter of introduction we can provide that. In fact a copy was included in your directory package. If you need our help – please ask. If you need numbers for their tax filings we can provide those because MLERF is a 501 (C) 3 and the bank can also benefit from their donation to MLERF.

## **SIGHT AWARDS**

Has your cub presented a Sight Award? Has your club earned the right to present a Sight Award?

### WHAT IS A SIGHT AWARD?

The **SIGHT AWARD** is one of the more challenging awards for a club to



earn for presentation. It is a prestigious award that can only be earned once a year.

The **SIGHT AWARD** is an award which can be used to recognize an individual or organization that has contributed or displayed outstanding and dedicated service to their club or community with ideals of eye research in mind.

A Lion, Lioness, or Leo club may qualify for the Sight Award when there is a minimum increase of **\$1,000** in their eye research donation from the previous year. A three-year average may also be used at the discretion of the Executive Board. Applications with complete requirements are available from any officer or director of the Corporation.

As we near the end of this year we encourage clubs to know how their donations this year compare to last year especially if you are nearing an additional \$1000 in donations. A club may want to add enough to their donations to reach the \$1000 increase.

#### JOURNEY FOR SIGHT

The "Journey To Sight" program began after the 1982 Lions Clubs International Convention. It was an idea created by Lions Clubs International designed to enable Lions Clubs and Districts to raise funds for sight related activities and increase Club and District visibility and reputation in their communities.

Massachusetts Lions Eye Research Fund, Inc. adopted "Journey To Sight" shortly after the 1982 International Convention and changed the name to **Journey For Sight**. The first **Journey For Sight** Weekend was held in May of 1983. The initial idea was for all clubs to hold a **Journey For Sight** Project on the same weekend in May each year. The goal was to generate additional funds for MLERF over and above a Lions Club's usual annual donations. The goal was that the funds generated by the current 5 existing Districts through the Journey For Sight fundraisers would be the equivalent of a sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) District.

Today, **Journey For Sight** projects occur all year long throughout the five Lions Districts. (Y-A-N-K-S).

Clubs earn a Banner Patch for their first Journey For Sight Project and each subsequent year the club can earn a Journey For Sight Rocker.

#### \$5.00 from each Helen Keller Pin purchased by Massachusetts Lions Clubs will be credited to that club as a JOURNEY FOR SIGHT donation.

#### TRUST AND ENDOWMENT FUND

As a Lion, you are probably already familiar with other MLERFI programs such as Pennies for Sight and Journey for Sight. What you may not know is that the MLERFI Trust and Endowment Fund was created in order to establish a source of stable. continuous income. This income is used to guarantee the perpetuation of grants to the local research institutions that MLERFI supports. Gifts from you, other Lions, and the public, are the foundation of MLERFI's continued success. Your gift to the Trust and Endowment Fund provides much-needed financial aid to ensure that grant funds will be available to all eligible research institutions. In addition, Trust and Endowment Fund gifts bridge the gap between what MLERFI receives in direct donations and what it actually costs to support all the research projects, keeping grant denials to a minimum.

Presidential Grants are also made possible from funds which are allowed to be withdrawn from the Trust & Endowment Fund.

In the EyeCatcher there was a letter inviting Lions to make even a very small donation to the Trust and Endowment Fund. We hope you will help to sustain this important fund with whatever donation you feel comfortable making.

## LIONS HAVE ANSWERED THE CHALLENGE SINCE 1925



Since 1925, when Helen Keller asked us to be her *"Knights Of The Blind"* we have embraced the mission of *"eradicating preventable blindness"* and have stayed true to that mission. Lions have achieved enormous success worldwide through Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF). In a recent message LCIF Chairperson Barry Palmer pointed out the following:

"Every day, you provide disaster relief, empower our young people and serve our communities. <u>You also remain committed to saving sight</u>. Whether you are conducting vision screenings, distributing eyeglasses or medicine, you are giving the gift of sight.

Together with LCIF and partners like The Carter Center, Lions have helped to restore sight to 7.7 million people through cataract surgeries; prevented serious vision loss for more than 30 million; provided over 271



million treatments for river blindness; built or expanded 660 eye care hospitals and clinics; and trained 681,000 eye care specialists and eye health workers. Congratulations, Lions!






