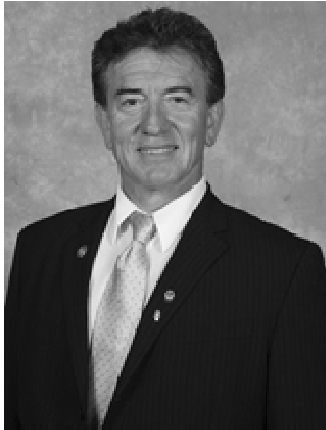


**DR. JERIMIAH MYERS
