PDG Joe was a District Governor in 1983-1984 when a Youth Exchange student Paivi Harittu from Finland was tragically killed in an auto mobile accident while visiting Florida. He worked very hard to get this Youth Exchange Scholarship Trust Fund program started as a memorial to her.

The Lion Joe we knew was a small built GENTLEMAN and LION who was a GIANT in keeping his promise to help others in need.

The \$1,000 scholarships are available to High School Senior students in Lions District 35-O. They may be used for visiting a foreign country under the Lions Clubs International Youth Exchange Program, or to further their education.

The program is open to young men and women who are eager to learn about another culture and willing to share their own way of life. They come to serve as ambassadors of their country.
