RULES

- (1) ... To authenticate your entry, the cover page must be on club stationary and contain the 'daytime' phone number of the person submitting the entry
- (2) ... The length of the entry 'will not' be a consideration
- (3) ... E-mail entries will not be accepted
- (4) ... submit **Six (6)** copies of your entry by U.S. Mail

On Sunday morning we will also be presenting the awards for the Lion and Lioness "**Best Club Newsletter**" and "**Best Club Scrapbook**." Entries in these categories may be turned in to the Convention Registration area prior to Noon on Saturday, March 26, 2011. If you want them returned they must be picked up prior to the close of Registration on Saturday afternoon. The committee will not be responsible for lost entries.
