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Health Services Update-Adult Low Vision



Suzie and Siobhan: Suzie is our client, Siobhan is our Vision Rehabilitation Therapist intern. Suzie lives in Batavia. She is the sole caregiver of her 98-year-old mother. She used to come down to our office for training, but her mother needed full-time care. Now, our in-home training option is perfect for her. Cody and Siobhan bring their training table and chairs, set them up in Suzie's garage and open the door for circulation. This way they are not exposing Suzie's mother to any danger. So far, Suzie has learned to use her iPad to take and


email photos (that she needs for remote doctor appointments), create lists, use Facetime (so other family members can see her mom), and text all her friends. She also listens to audio books when she goes to bed. What she calls a little treat for herself.



Second Sense Beyond vision loss



Charlie and Brad: Charlie was a truck driver and lost his vision in an accident. He is now going to Northwestern University and is a senior. He is learning mobility training to prepare for his next career. Brad is an intern working with our Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist for the training hours he needs to graduate -- as the first blind graduate in the mobility program at NIU.





Brooke is a small business owner. She has a degenerative condition, but has never had mobility training. She is learning to travel using public transit in Chicago to get from her new home in Edgewater to her business.



Cyndi has had vision loss most of her life, but made do without training. She stopped working in her late twenties to be a stay-at-home mom, which included home schooling her two

children. She lived in Downers Grove, but has just moved to the Chicago so Cydni could travel more independently. During their most recent lesson, our instructor worked with Cyndi and her husband to help them travel more easily as a team. This can be stressful for both parties, and our instructor stressed to Cyndi how important it is for her to carry her cane in the open so other pedestrians can see that she is visually impaired. This helps her husband guide her better as people will move out of her way when they know she can't see them. Cyndi emailed us the



next day to report that she and her husband went on a 2.5 mile walk and it was so much easier! They enjoyed themselves, no frustrations at all.

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STUDENT LOW VISION CLINICS

The Student Low Vision Program will be moving forward, either at the school campus or at the clinic location.

Fall/Spring 2020-2021

SEEING IS BELIEVING

"Now more than ever, students with low vision need the benefits the SEEING IS BELIEVING Program provides. As we all take precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19, it is imperative each student has access to their own magnifiers, telescopes and other assistive devices provided by this program.

CHICAGO LIGHTHOUSE SEEING IS BELIEVING UPDATE



Due to COVID-19 and school closures it's been a slower start to the year as far as dates of clinics. For the school year to date, we have scheduled 3 upcoming clinics in October and November. 2 will be at the schools where school is open for in person learning these are for North suburban special education district, Palatine and Schaumburg. A 3rd is scheduled at the Lighthouse in Glenview and will serve students from north suburban special education office, Arlington Heights/Mount Prospect.

We have not had to resort to virtual clinics as of yet!

The CPS clinics will be held at the main Lighthouse and we are in contact with the vision coordinator to schedule those.

In total CPS and 4 other school board vision coordinators have been contacted to schedule their clinics. The above are the confirmed to date. Some of the schools are pushing things back as far as a commitment date in hopes that their schools will be open for some in person learning which will allow our clinics to be there. This will likely lead to us being busier in the winter and early spring next year.

SPECTRIOS INSTITUTE SEEING IS BELIEVING UPDATE



September 23rd 6 students seen, October 7th 5 Students seen. We have another clinic 10-14.

More Clinics are being scheduled

"We had one 2nd grader who could only read 3 letter words, we fitted him with a telescope and had his mother get him a monitor because his tablet for e-learning is too small for him to see.

His mother cried she was so thankful".

JACKSONVILLE STUDENT LOW VISION CLINIC UPDATE

Good afternoon. This is Jasmine Wells from ISVI. I wanted to inform you that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, ISVI is still learning remotely at this time. Due to the nature of our program, the doctors and our administrators have decided that it is not the safest option for us to host the fall clinic during this time. They are looking at extending the spring clinic to more days to support a larger group of students.

Dear Lions Members & Friends,

The Lions of Illinois Foundation partners with Spectrios Institute for Low Vision, the Illinois College of Optometry, and the Chicago Lighthouse for the Blind to provide a FREE comprehensive visual evaluation to Illinois students in grades K-12.

Students are referred by special education staff employed by the Illinois Board of Education. The exams are performed by licensed optometrists that travel to the different screening locations throughout the state.

Other components of the program include:

- Referring parents to vocational counseling
- Braille reading instruction
- Orientation and mobility training for child
- Adaptive technology training

The LIF "Seeing is Believing" Low Vision Program for Students provides a visually impaired child with the optical tools and training necessary to help prevent further vision loss or even blindness. But more importantly, these are the children we have promised to help by preserving what sight they have left. Their future is in our hands.
