Dues Structure

The Lion year runs from July 1st through June 30th. It is broken down into two halves

- July 1st to December 31st
- January 1st to June 30th.

Confirm member roster with the LCI list of members. Drop any members in December and June to avoid being charged dues for members that are deceased, non-payment of dues etc.

There are two separate dues structures

Lions Clubs International (LCI) invoices at \$21.50 per member

District/MD-1 State invoices at \$7.50 per member

(District 1-A Dues @ \$2.50 per member/ Multiple District 1 Dues @ \$5.00 per member)

Your club will be billed July 1st and January 1st for both.

There is also a one-time \$35.00 entrance fee for *New Members* that is paid to Lions Club International (LCI).

Minimum dues club should be charging is \$58.00. You may charge more to ensure you have enough money in your administrative fund to help cover administrative costs. You may invoice members annually or semi-annually.

Family Plan... If two or more Lions join from the same family (i.e. mother/son /daughter, husband/wife, etc.), and live in the same house LCI has a "Family Plan" where one Lion in the family unit pays the full price of \$43.00 as head-of-household and the other family members pay \$21.50 (half-price) to LCI.

Importance of paying on time: Keep your club in good standing: In accordance with Article VI, Section 5 of the District 1-A Constitution and By-Laws all Lions Clubs in good standing with District 1-A and Lions Clubs International are entitled to One (1) Delegate and One (1) Alternate for each Ten (10) members or major fraction thereof who have been enrolled for at least one year and one day, based upon membership records as of February 1st as certified by Lions Clubs International. A newly chartered club that is less than one year and one day is allowed One (1) Delegate and One (1) Alternate.

A Lions Club, to be considered in good standing must have all of its' District and State per capita bills paid, is due and owing Lions Clubs International no more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), which shall be certified by Lions Clubs International. Outstanding bills must be paid 15 days prior to the Convention to Lions Club International and the District to be eligible to vote. Any monies paid at the Convention will bring your clubs bills current but will not entitle your club to vote.
