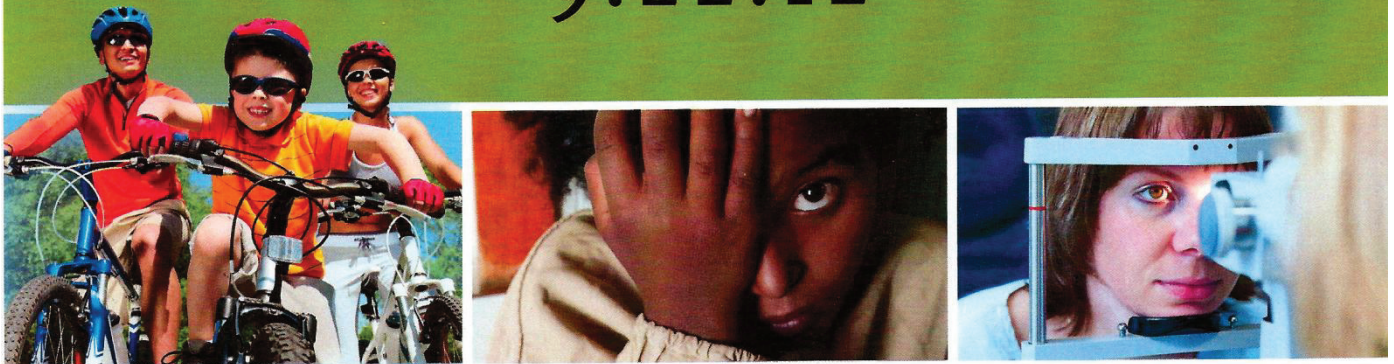

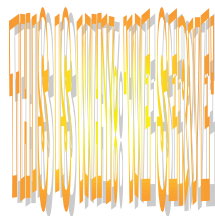


UTAH LIONS FOUNDATION

The Foundation had somewhat of a slow year last year for requests for assistance.

Four requests were approved for a total of \$4,100. This year at our first Trustee meeting we approved one for \$2,486. Also at the first meeting we reviewed and approved our 2012-2013 budget and approved a donation to the Utah Lions Eye Bank of \$20,000. Last year we reviewed both the Articles of Incorporation and the By-Laws to see what might need to be up-dated. Left the Articles of Incorporation as they were and made several amendments to the By-Laws which were voted on and approved at the MD 28 Convention. The Foundation is again working with the Walk With The Blind (WWTB), which is now a District 28-U Project, Fund raiser to secure donations for both the Utah

First Western Advisors (Charles Schwab) Account.

Start	\$451,094	End	\$410,240

Note: The Market had a downturn which took the account down to \$405,187 and on 12/2011 \$20,000 was moved to the Banking accounts.

Morgan Stanley Smith Barney Account.

Note: Because of the type of investments, the Market downturn was not as much as the Charles Schwab account, but it did go down to \$29,940.
