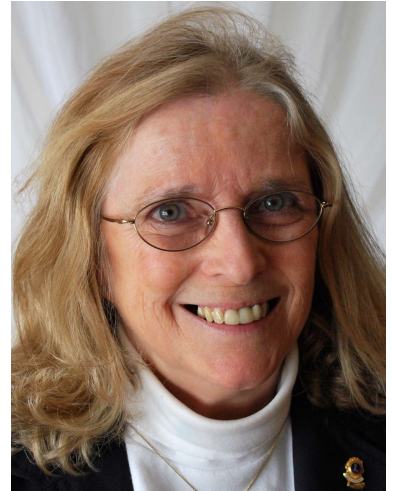

At our District meeting I discussed several classifications of clubs with membership issues: First, clubs with less than 20 members need to look at how to increase membership. Second, clubs with less than 15 members is serious. The CEP program is a great tool, ask your Zone Chair. Also contact the DG Team for help. Third, Less than 10 members in a club need rebuilding and extension help. We will contact you. Your zone chair and zone mentor as well as several members of our GMT& GLT team will be there to assist you and the sooner the better. We want you back. We will also be placing guiding lions in troubled clubs. Any club that consistently loses members is a sign that something is wrong and help is needed. One of the many goals for both VDGs will be working to assist these clubs.

If you hear a rumor – do not spread it. This is not what Lions are about. We are going to be positive and remember our Code of Ethics and the Golden Rule. We cannot afford to lose members due to hurtful words and statements. STOP and THINK before you speak: “Would I want to have this said about me? How would I respond?”. We are a family and we take care of each other.

Now to work. Remember if you have questions or trouble with something new, ask the person just above you. Formulas and equations play an important part in our lives. They are powerful tools - a road map to success - that make many things possible and others, simply easier. According to Einstein, the simple formula, $e=mc^2$ describes the workings of the entire universe. I may not be a Nobel Prize-winning physicist, but I also have a formula, one that I know works based on 27 years as a Lion:
