The objective of the **PRIDE** program is to give those Lions who always go above and beyond what is necessary to be considered an active member the recognition that they deserve. At the same time the program is designed to lead long time members on a path that will continue and strengthen their commitment to both the District and their individual clubs. This program cannot be completed without being actively involved in your own club's functions as well as helping out at the District level.

The **PRIDE** program for Lions is a tool that can be used to help focus members to become and remain *involved with the club, district, and their community.*
