- Has been helping to feed the poor and hungry in our communities since 1982. •
- Collects large donations of food from the food industry and distributes it to charitable agencies serving • hungry and disadvantaged people in 23 counties.
- Provides over 35 million pounds of food a year to 1,000 agencies from Plattsburgh to Newburgh, in • urban, rural, and suburban communities.
- In partnership with the Patroon Land Foundation, is developing a self-sustaining farm that grows large • quantities of high quality vegetables every year. Currently, the Farm has grown over 1,000,000 pounds of diverse, fresh produce!
